Letterboxing is an older version of the same game, using traditional compasses and fancier puzzles, and trading images with artfully carved rubber stamps.

Bring: a compass and/or a GPS unit, if you have one. Car-navigation systems don't work too well for this. Dress to be outdoors and do a bit of hiking.

Description: Songs and games are a special part of Girl Scout history, and they create special memories for each girl. Learn some classics, and some new ones! Fun for all ages, but geared mostly toward Daisies, Brownies and Juniors.
