**Lincoln Exhibitions at the Indiana State Museum**

*All Age Levels*

On February 12, 2010 the Indiana State Museum will open TWO world-class Abraham Lincoln exhibitions. The first, WITH MALICE TOWARD NONE: THE ABRAHAM LINCOLN BICENTENNIAL EXHIBITION comes from the Library of Congress and travels to just five US cities. The exhibit features the Bible upon which Lincoln and, most recently, President Obama took the oath of office; the contents of Lincoln's pockets the night he was assassinated; as well as letters, photographs, maps, sketches, political cartoons, period engravings, speeches and artifacts from Lincoln's political career and presidency. This exhibit remains at the museum until April 11, 2010. During February, signed copies of both the Emancipation Proclamation and the 13th Amendment will be on display; after February, they will rotate.

The second exhibition, WITH CHARITY FOR ALL: THE LINCOLN FINANCIAL FOUNDATION COLLECTION tells the story of Lincoln, the man. Since his birth on a farm in the Kentucky wilderness some 200 years ago, Lincoln lore has transformed him into an almost mythological figure. WITH CHARITY FOR ALL: THE LINCOLN FINANCIAL FOUNDATION COLLECTION highlights artifacts that paint a picture of an ordinary man who rose to become, perhaps, the greatest leader in American history. This exhibition is open to July 25, 2010.

There is no additional charge beyond museum admission to view these exhibitions but advance timed-tickets are required.
