

# Family camp weekends for Girl Scout families

Here is a special opportunity for all Girl Scouts in central Indiana and their families!

You are invited to get away from the crowds and busy highways to explore the beautiful campgrounds at both Camp Windigo and Camp Gallahue. You'll share a wonderful family experience, meet other Girl Scout families, and make new friends!

These two holiday weekends are wonderful occasions to use the facilities of Camp Gallahue and Camp Windigo (Labor Day). We have planned some activities to complement your weekend of leisure.

## Camp Gallahue

### Memorial and Labor Day

Enjoy the lovely hills and valleys of Camp Gallahue. This beautiful resident/troop camp is located in Brown County.

Lifeguards will be on duty at the waterfront for swimming, canoeing, sailing, open kayaking, and fishing.

**Hillcrest** – three wings; each wing has either 12 or 14 beds, private restrooms, showers, and modern kitchen.

**Fee per wing:** \$100

**Four tent units** – units consist of a large activity cabin with ten nearby platform tents for sleeping and pit latrines. Cabins have modern kitchens and substantial activity space to be shared by families staying in the unit, for get-together, cooking, etc.

**Fee per family:** \$40

**Adirondack unit (Harley's Hill)** – three sided shelter for sleeping, picnic style shelter with tables, a pit latrine, and a fire bowl. No electricity or water.

**Fee per family:** \$25

**Primitive camping sites** – unlimited site capacity. Sites include fire bowls, fire grates and picnic tables. Water available from a pump located in the center of the valley.

**Fee per family:** \$25

**Picnic area** – available for day use.

**Hills of Gallahue trail** – provides a rugged seven and a half-mile trail through the hills of Brown County. After hiking the trail, The Hills of Gallahue patch is available for purchase from Girl Scouts of Central Indiana Showcase.

## Camp Windigo

### Labor Day

Come enjoy the quiet and peaceful country setting in Upland. You will enjoy camp based activities: fishing, canoeing, yard games, rope runners, nature trails, corn/grass maze, family game night, etc... While there drive over to Splash House in Marion for swimming, water slides and a lazy river. You can also visit Taylor University for Letterboxing and walk Garfield Trail in beautiful Grant County. Wrap up the weekend with an ice cream social and a pitch-in dinner!

Small craft certified staff will be on duty at the waterfront for canoeing and fishing.

**Singing Tree Lodge** – heated, has a full kitchen, handicap accessible indoor restroom and shower. This lodge sleeps 28.

**Fee per wing:** \$100

**Director's Cabin** – sleeps 6, has a full kitchen and restroom.

**Fee per family:** \$40

**Three tent units** – Platform Tents are of a deck type wood construction measuring approximately 12' x 14' with a canvas tent covering. Each tent contains 4 cots/mattresses; each unit has a fire circle or grill, wash station available with outside latrines.

**Fee per family:** \$25

**Primitive camping sites** – unlimited site capacity. Sites include fire bowls, fire grates and picnic tables. Water available from a pump located nearby.

**Fee per family:** \$25

**Picnic area** – available for day use.

**Windigo trail** – provides a narrative self guide trail to learn about trees and the heritage. Patch is available for purchase from Girl Scouts of Central Indiana Showcase.
