Thanks Badge Award Nomination Guidelines

This awarded recognition is submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department and approved by the council board of directors. Nomination forms and letters must be submitted together to the Volunteer Services Department by February 9. This award recognizes an adult member whose service is significantly outstanding and benefits the entire council or the entire Girl Scout movement. Examples of appropriate nominees include, but are not limited to the following:

- A volunteer who has impacted an increase in the percentage of adult-generated funding for the council.
- A facilitator who receives consistently high ratings and increases participation in adult leadership development throughout the council.

Criteria

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has provided significantly outstanding service benefiting the council or entire Girl Scout movement.
3. The nominee's service significantly exceeds beyond expectations of their position.

Nomination

Individuals or troops/groups familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form accompanied by four letters of endorsement. Letters must be written by someone other than the nominator and must demonstrate the nominee's accomplishments. The nomination must quantify and outline the scope and impact on the council or entire Girl Scout movement. The Volunteer Services Department will notify the nominator when the award is approved or denied.
